Report on Annual Expenditures for Travel, Hospitality and Conferences

As required by the Treasury Board *Directive on Travel, Hospitality, Conference and Event Expenditures*, this report provides information on the total annual expenditures for each of travel, hospitality and conference fees for the Canadian Tourism Commission (CTC), operating as Destination Canada (DC), for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2016.

This information is updated annually and does not contain information withheld under the *Access* to *Information Act* or the *Privacy Act*.

Expenditures on travel, hospitality and conference fees incurred by the CTC relate to activities in support of the CTC's mandate to promote the interests of the tourism industry and to market Canada as a desirable tourist destination. The CTC markets Canada abroad to leisure and business travellers to increase arrivals and grow Canada's tourism economy. We work with partners in provincial and territorial governments and in the tourism industry to help Canada's tourism businesses reach international markets. The CTC's purpose is to sustain a vibrant and profitable tourism industry by marketing Canada as an internationally competitive, premier four-season tourism destination where travelers can indulge in extraordinary experiences.

Reporting to Parliament through the Minister of Small Business and Tourism, the CTC's legislative requirements are outlined in the *Canadian Tourism Commission Act*. Through collaboration and partnerships with the private sector, as well as with the governments of Canada, the provinces and territories, the CTC works with the tourism sector to maintain Canada's competitiveness and generate wealth for Canadians by stimulating demand for Canada's visitor economy.
