

## **KEY MESSAGES**

• In October 2019, overnight arrivals of international visitors to Canada surpassed the 1.6 million mark for the first time ever, bringing the number of tourist arrivals over the first 10 months of 2019 to a record high of 19.6 million visitors.

## **HIGHLIGHTS**

- Air and cruise arrivals from long-haul markets: In October 2019, overnight arrivals by non-land modes of entry expanded in all Destination Canada long-haul markets (+5.6%), with the exception of China (-10.4%).
- Among the Destination Canada long-haul markets in October 2019, France emerged as the top source of
  overnight visitors for non-land arrivals (52,198), surpassing the UK (52,136) for the first time ever and China
  (45,921) for the first time since 2016.
- Year-to-date October 2019, the United Kingdom remains Canada's top source of overnight non-land arrivals from long-haul markets (661,928), while France (531,483) edged China (527,852) in second spot for the first time in 2019.
- Spurred by double-digit growth in air arrivals direct from overseas, India had the largest year-over-year growth in non-land arrivals in October 2019 (+26.8%), followed by Germany (+16.5%) and Japan (+14.1%).
   Australian visitors arriving by air direct from overseas also expanded at a double-digit pace that month, significantly reducing the share of air arrivals via the United States.

## • Air arrivals via the United States:

- Continuing a pattern experienced over 20 of the last 22 months, air arrivals via the United States from Destination Canada's nine long-haul markets further declined in October 2019 (-9.6%), bringing year-to-date the contraction for this mode of entry -6.1%.
- There is a trend toward direct air connectivity from Destination Canada's long-haul markets and away for air arrival via the United States: Between the four-year period spanning 2015 to 2019, the share arrivals by air direct from overseas increased by 10 percentage points from 73.9% in 2015 to 83.9% in 2019. Over that period, direct air capacity from these long-haul markets increased 40%, representing an additional 2.5 million seats.
- United States: In October 2019, Canada registered robust gains in overnight arrivals of US residents by automobile (+6.2%) and air (+8.5%). Year-to-date, however, US Auto arrivals has grown at a slower pace of 3.5% compared to air arrivals, which soared 12.6%. Arrivals by other modes of entries reached 1.3 million visitors. Owing to a change in data collection methods, the 2019 visitor metrics for other modes of entry (in particular pedestrians) are not comparable to prior years.

## **DATA RELEASE NOTICE**

This analysis focuses on US arrivals by land and by air, and on long-haul arrivals by air and cruise only.

Long-haul tourist arrivals by land were the subject of significant changes with respect to data collection and the identification of country of residence starting in August 2018. As a result of these changes, monthly arrivals by land are not comparable to data collected before August 2018. Year-over-year arrival performance results should only be evaluated for non-land, long-haul arrivals. This does not apply to US auto arrivals.
